

About the Institute

Bhilai Institute of Technology (BIT) Durg, established in the year 1986, with a cherished vision of delivering excellent professional education and creating value based globally competitive professionals. It offers seven undergraduate & postgraduate courses in Engineering, Masters of Business Administration, Masters of Computer Applications and Doctoral Programs (Ph.D). With 35 years of rich standing in the educational field, BIT has been ranked in the 150 - 200 band under Engineering category by NIRF 2017 and 2018 and band 251-300 by NIRF 2020. Seven UG programs have been accredited by National Board Accreditation (NBA) and 'A' grade in cycle 1 by NAAC. BIT is well connected through rail as well as air network. It is at about 1km from the Durg Railway station on Howrah-Mumbai line and is about 45 km from the Swami Vivekanand Airport at Raipur, the capital city of Chhattisgarh state.
