



Memorandum of Understanding

between

National Chin-Yi University of Technology

and

Bhilai Institute of Technology, Durg, India

In order to advance friendly relations between Taiwan and India, National Chin-Yi University of Technology and Bhilai Institute of Technology, Durg join in the following agreement on the promotion of education and academic exchanges between the two universities.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage research cooperation and interaction between their colleges, departments, research institutes, faculty members, and students to the extent that they are able, under provisions of this agreement, and endeavor to cooperate in the fields with which both parties are concerned.

Both universities agree on the following general forms of cooperation:

- 1 • Mutual exchange and visit of faculty members for academic activities
- 2 • Mutual exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research
- 3 • Joint degree programs for students at graduate and undergraduate levels
- 4 • Collaborative research activities

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific case.

Both universities understand that all the financial arrangements should be negotiated and will depend upon the availability of funds.

It is understood that the implementation of this agreement will commence upon the signing date and that this agreement will continue thereafter for five years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual agreement. The possibility and the terms of a renewal of the agreement will be discussed by the representatives of the two universities no less than six months prior to the natural termination of the current agreement.

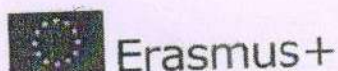

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (herein after referred to as MoU) is entered into on this 12th Day of March, 2020 between Bhilai Institute of Technology, Durg herein referred to as BIT Durg and Globussoft, Bhilai. The scope of the MoU, the roles and responsibilities of the parties of the MoU are given below:

ALLIANCE OBJECTIVE

This document outlines a strategic understanding between BIT Durg and Globussoft to work together in order to facilitate Machine Learning studies and research at the campus of BIT Durg. The primary aim of this partnership is to aid BIT Durg, financially and technically in promoting research in the area of Machine Learning and allied areas like Data Analytics, Machine Learning Platforms on Cloud and Parallel Computing for Machine Learning. This alliance and the subsequent aid thereafter will help BIT Durg to train their students on latest Machine Learning technologies and tools and to position them to support India's Information Technology initiative. As opposed to a one time implementation, this is a strategic initiative and requires the total commitment of both BIT Durg and Globussoft.

NOW THIS MoU WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

DEFINITIONS AS USED IN THIS MoU:

"MoU" means this instrument executed by BIT Durg and Globussoft and subsequent amendments issued to the MoU by mutual consent as provided herein.

"Program" means the Research Program that is the subject of this MoU.

"Center of Excellence" means the laboratory facility for study and research of Machine Learning technologies at BIT Durg campus.





1. THE COLLABORATION

With this collaboration Globussoft will provide an annual grant of Rupees Ten lakhs as a fund for pursuing Machine Learning studies and research for three years to BIT Durg. This fund will be disbursed as an amount of Rupees Two and a half lakhs (Rs 2.5 Lakhs) per quarter and Globussoft reserves the right to continue/discontinue the financial support depending upon the progress of the program and fulfillment of the objectives of the collaboration. A significant portion of the fund will be utilized to pay stipends to selected students of BIT Durg for pursuing their research. The stipend provided to students will be directly credited to their students through cheque/DD/NEFT.

This Agreement will become effective upon the date of signature by both Parties. It shall remain valid for a period of three (3) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be modified by written mutual consent of both Parties. BIT Durg will utilize this grant to promote the study and research in Machine Learning and provide a workspace in the form of a dedicated lab facility. This facility will be named as "**Sumit Ghosh Center of Excellence for Machine Learning**" to honor the financial support from Mr. Sumit Ghosh, founder of Globussoft and an alumnus of BIT Durg. The research grant provided by Globussoft through will be utilized for the following expenses of activities through the Center of Excellence

- 1.1 Stipend to students for undertaking* research projects in Machine Learning and allied areas, with tangible outputs in the form of project reports, research publications in journals/conference, recognition in project competitions/Hackathons and /or implementations.
- 1.2 Honorarium to internal/external faculty members/trainers/ resource persons employed for conducting training sessions/content creation/assessment of students projects/research guidance and/or any other activity carried out through the Center of Excellence.
- 1.3 Publication Fee for the publication of research findings in the form of research papers/reports in journals/conferences/technical journals of high repute like SCI/SCI-Extended/Scopus/UGC/IEEE/ indexed journals etc.
- 1.4 Recording and uploading of video lectures for Machine Learning topics on Intranet/Internet
- 1.5 Organizing National/Regional Workshops/Conferences or similar events for the promotion of Machine Learning research and training.
- 1.6 Any other activity that promotes the study and research of Machine Learning with the consent of the program coordination committee

2. THE BENEFITS TO THE PARTIES

2.1 BENEFITS TO THE BHILAI INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, DURG

- 2.1.1 Opportunity to emerge as one of the competent entities in the academic circles in study, research and development in the area of Machine Learning
- 2.1.2 Provide students with a dedicated facility for Machine Learning research established using financial support from Globussoft.
- 2.1.3 Provide motivation to students interested in Machine Learning in the form of stipend/financial rewards for pursuing Machine Learning research.
- 2.1.4 Opportunity for the faculty and students of BIT Durg to develop skills and implement ideas as research projects in the areas of Machine Learning.
- 2.1.5 Opportunity for students to have early exposure to Machine Learning research problems faced by the research community and the industry and employ formal methods of research to encounter them.

2.2 BENEFITS TO THE GLOBUSSOFT

- 2.2.1 Creation of a resource pool in the areas of Machine Learning and allied areas like Data Analysis, Cloud Computing and Parallel Computing.
- 2.2.2 Availability of skilled students trained in Machine Learning from the Center of Excellence for projects which could be potential interns/employees for Globussoft as well as the Business Partners of Globussoft.
- 2.2.3 Promote Industry-Academic Interaction through the activities at Center of Excellence to be established at the campus of BIT Durg.
- 2.2.4 Acquire Intellectual Property in the form of Copyrights/Patents awarded through any product/technology designed or developed at the proposed Center of Excellence.





3. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 3.1 Neither BIT Durg nor Globussoft is or will be an agent or legal representative or partner of the other. Neither of them is or shall be responsible for the debts incurred by the other or be bound by any contracts or representations made by the other or any obligations undertaken by the other. Neither of them is or shall be an employee or franchisee of the other, nor does this MoU create a joint venture or any similar relationship between them.
- 3.2 Neither party will make any representations pertaining to the other or its business or affairs, without the express prior written consent and approval of the other.

4. MONITORING OF IMPLEMENTATION

Prof. Sudip Bhattacharya, Associate Professor, BIT Durg will act as the primary liaison between the two organizations. A Co-ordination Committee consisting of two faculty members from BIT Durg and two executives nominated by Globussoft will do the planning and monitoring of the implementation of the various aspects of this MoU. There will be quarterly reviews and audit of the expenses for the program by nominated members from Globussoft and/or BIT Durg. This review/audit would primarily focus on the progress of the program, outputs delivered through the Center of Excellence and the effective utilization of the grant.

5. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The intellectual property rights of any product or technology designed/developed at the Center of Excellence for Machine Learning will belong to Globussoft. However Globussoft on its discretion can waive of the rights and allow the research scholar from BIT Durg to file a copyright/patent for the research output. Any such waiver of rights should be given in written. Any software product provided by Globussoft to BIT Durg for this research program will at all times remain proprietary of Globussoft which however, hereby grants to BIT Durg non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use the same internally. The softwares being provided to BIT Durg through this MoU shall be governed by the applicable license agreements of the respective softwares. BIT Durg unconditionally agrees to comply with such terms and conditions.

6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Under no circumstances any party is liable for the damage, to records or data, as also claims for special, incidental, or indirect damages or for any economic consequential damages (including loss of profit or savings) of the other party.

7. GENERAL

- i. This MoU may be terminated by either party through a notice of one month. Either party may terminate this MoU if either of the parties is frustrated by reasons beyond its control from going ahead with the implementation of the provision of this MoU. The provisions contained in Clauses 5 ("Intellectual Property Rights"), 6 ("Limitation of Liability") and 7 will survive any such termination.
- ii. It is understood that during the course of this MoU it may be necessary for either party to disclose confidential/proprietary information to the other. The disclosure of any such information or data between the parties shall be made pursuant to an executed Confidentiality Agreement.
- iii. There shall be no liability on the part of any party to the other arising from the termination of this MoU.
- iv. This MoU is not binding on either of the parties hereto, except as specifically set out hereto. This MoU is intended to express the broad understanding of the parties and as a broad framework for working together on a specific opportunity as detailed herein.
- v. The terms of the applicable software license agreements and terms relating to confidentiality under this MoU shall survive the term of the MoU.
- vi. Neither party may use the other's corporate name or any trade mark or name or any other items or assets protected by intellectual property rights, including but not restricted to, use in any promotional material, press releases, advertisements, communications, stationery, web sites, or the like. However the news regarding this collaboration can be shared on the official websites if BIT Durg/Globussoft, print media and social media.
- vii. Only bonafide students of BIT Durg and regular faculty members/staff will be eligible for carrying out research at the Center of Excellence described in this MoU.
- viii. Neither party will disclose the terms and conditions, of this MoU or any information connected with it or any information received from the other or otherwise during the implementation of this MoU or its subsequent amendments, if any, except as may be

required by law or on a strictly "need-to-know" basis for the purpose of implementing this MoU, or its subsequent amendments, if any, unless express prior written consent of the other party shall have been obtained in advance.

- ix. Save for their respective rights and obligations relating to Intellectual Property Rights (including the ownership of the Intellectual Property) as mentioned in Clause herein above, neither party is liable to the other for any damages or claims.
- x. Unless previously consented by both parties, there shall be no assignment of any interest under this MoU by any party hereto.
- xi. The laws of the Republic of India shall govern this MoU.
- xii. This MoU supersedes all proposals or other prior representations or communications, either oral or written.
- xiii. All communication between the parties shall be in writing and in English Language.

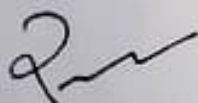
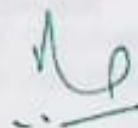

Department of Applied Mathematics, Bhilai Institute of Technology, Durg and Department of Mathematics, Govt. V. Y. T. PG Autonomous College, Durg Recognizing their mutual benefits, conclude this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the 17 Day of September, 2021.

They have agreed to the following protocols governing their collaboration on academic activities.

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Parties.
2. The Department of Applied Mathematics, BIT Durg agrees to collaborate on the following points with the Department of Mathematics, Govt. V. Y. T. PG Autonomous College, Durg.
 - a) The faculty member of Department of Applied Mathematics, BIT Durg and Department of Mathematics, Govt. V. Y. T. PG Autonomous College, Durg will work towards joint research projects. Thereby using research facilities developed / to be developed and exchange and visits of scholars, teachers shall be encouraged.

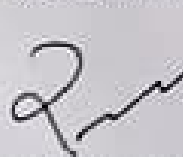
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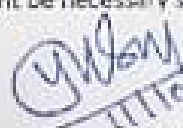

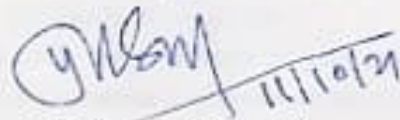
