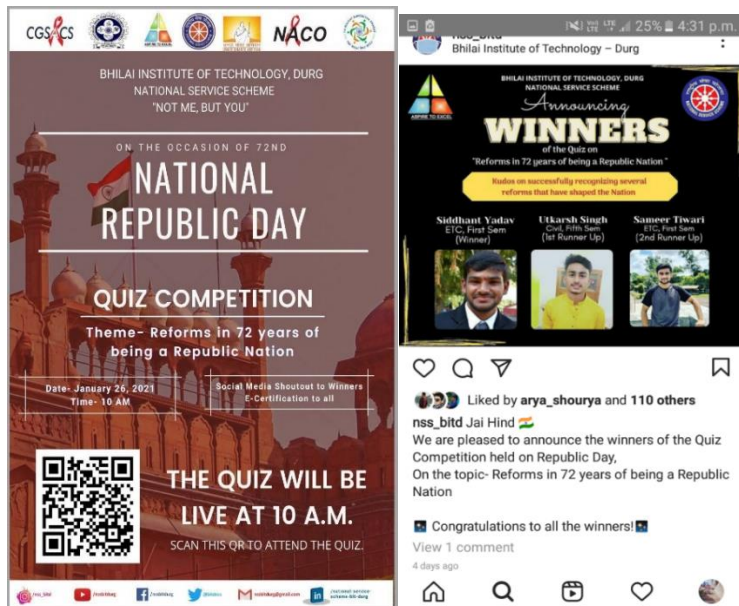

**Date: 31.10.19**

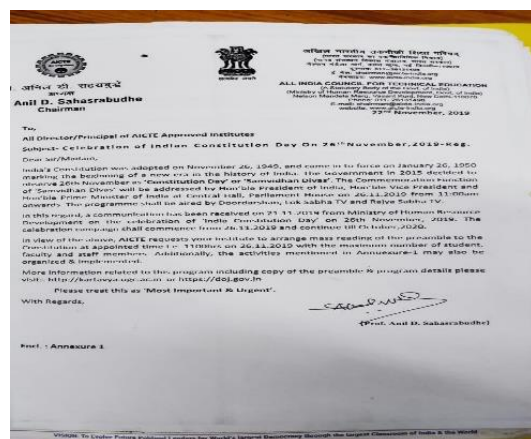

## Event: Constitution Day

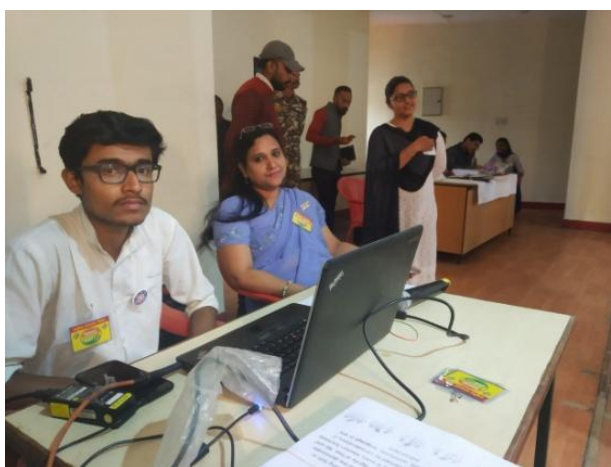
**Date: 26.11.19**

**Date: 31.10.18**

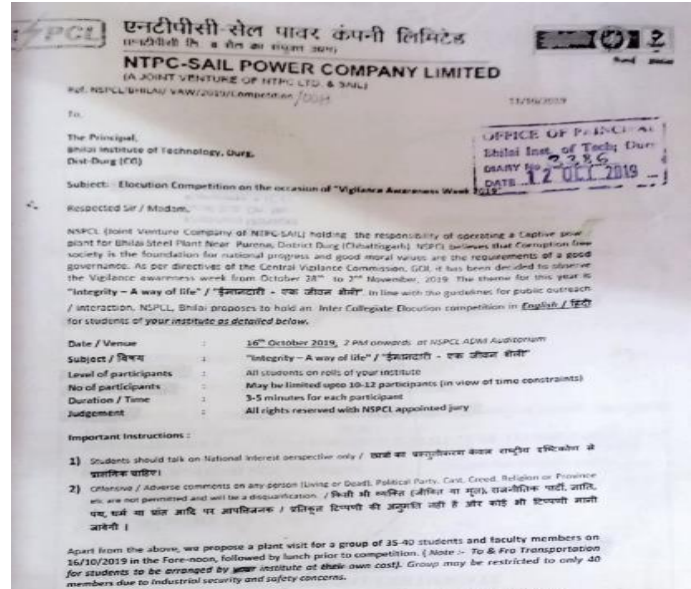
Pledge of Unity was taken by our volunteers. 35 volunteers participated in this event.
