3. Raspberry pi and Arduino

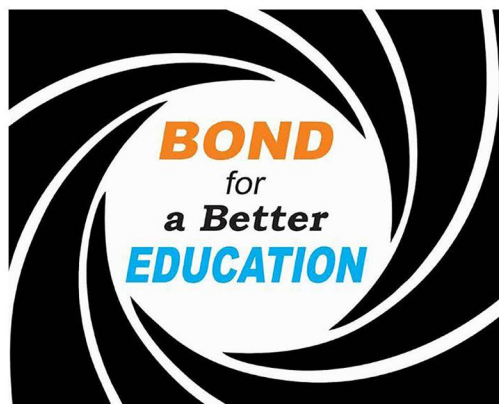

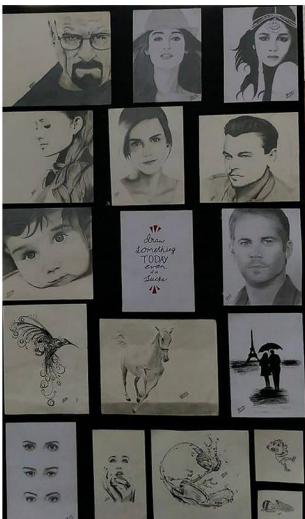

So after going through a series of elimination rounds during October 2017 to February 2018, Bhupesh Kumar Verma and his team have managed to reach the ultimate finals of the event that featured just 5 teams thus placing them amongst the top 0.5% of the competition.

Their theme was a harvester bot under the agricultural domain. It included features like image processing, path planning and setting up of serial communication both wired and wireless. They've used the technologies of raspberrypi 3 and microcontroller fire bird V atmega 2560 to accomplish the same.

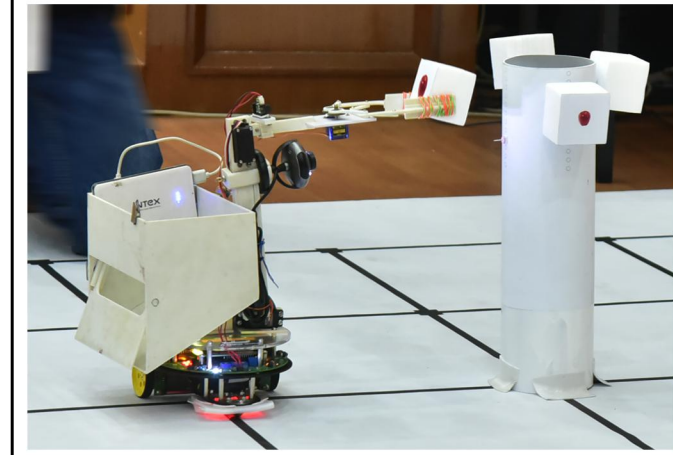

INTERVIEWING *PRAJAKTA TAWRI AIR-67 GATE CSE 2018*, 8TH SEMESTER STUDENT OF BIT DURGA.

1. What inspired you to prepare for GATE?

Ans. Like everyone else I was also confused for my career in 2nd year, I enquired about all the fields and exams like GATE, CAT, GRE, UPSC and then decided to opt for GATE because I wanted to remain in technical field and I saw many opportunities through GATE like M.Tech and PSU's, and it was my dream to study in IIT since 11th and after failure in JEE, GATE was the only way.



2. How many hours did you put in per day as per the stage of preparation?

Ans. Earlier when I started preparing for GATE in the 5th sem, I used to study 2-3 hours per day, then in the 6th and 7th sem it was very crucial time for me so I gave on an average 5 hr daily and at the end in the last 2 months I studied for 10-12 hours daily.

3. Can you share any preparation strategies with our readers?

Ans. For preparation strategy I will suggest that you first complete a subject by studying it from study material which you have, then try to solve previous year questions of GATE and then analyse yourself whether you are able to do it or not, if not then once again go through that topic and try to make it strong, follow same trend for all subjects one by one.

4. How to schedule study time and make timetables?

Ans. Making your time table is the most important thing you need during preparation, you need to have proper planning of everything, look at the syllabus before starting a subject and accordingly assign a deadline, and then try to complete that subject within that deadline.

5. How important do you feel mock tests are and why?

Ans. Mock tests are the most important part of preparation because once you complete your syllabus, you need to judge yourself and mocks will help you to do so, when you start giving mocks you will come to know about your weaknesses then try to focus on weak areas. By giving mocks you will end up building confidence for the real GATE exam.

6. What was the toughest aspect in your GATE preparation and how did you cope up with that?

Ans. When I was preparing there were many times when I lost hopes, got demotivated and felt low because it's natural when you are preparing for something big you will face so many distractions so it needs a lot of patience and dedication to face all these difficulties, you should have someone or something which motivates you and inspire you. I used to talk to my father whenever I felt low. So don't panic when you get demotivated because it's part of the preparation, just have the courage to face it.

7. Any advice for the future aspirants?

Ans. I wish all the very best to future aspirants, be confident, don't lose hope, always keep on trying never quit and believe in yourselves. All the best.
